# **GP** Quality Contract - Lancashire and South Cumbria

Following the update to the GP Quality Contract, we have raised some concerns with the Lancs & South Cumbria ICB. We are particularly concerned about the frailty element and confusion around whether patients who have declined an assessment will be counted towards the KPI target, as there appears to have been mixed messaging on this. Additionally, we are concerned about the MDT targets, which have the potential to be unachievable, especially for those areas where MDTs are not fully formed and functioning. We await clarity and guidance in response to these concerns from the ICB and will issue further information when we receive it.

#### **Compassionate Leadership Coaching - Lancashire and South Cumbria**

The LMC has commissioned Amanda Super Consulting Ltd to deliver Compassionate Leadership to practices across Lancashire & South Cumbria, as part of the resilience monies we have been awarded by the ICB. There are currently two elements that will be delivered: The Compassionate Leadership Coaching Programme and Introduction to Compassionate Leadership Workshops.

The Coaching Programmes are available via an application process to GPs and Practice Managers and the Workshops are accessible to Assistant Practice Managers, Reception Managers, Clerical Managers, Nurse Managers etc.
