

The event featured an insightful presentation by Dr Adam Janjua, LMC CEO, interactive workshops, and productive discussions focused on maximising achievement. Attendees had the opportunity to network, share best practice, and voice common challenges. Our aim was a Peer to Peer learning opportunity to encourage Practices to reach their maximum targets for this GPQC. As we know, the potential to receive the full quota of monies available from the ICB is currently extremely important. We remain positive in our hope that this event has provided this opportunity.

Chorley & South Ribble and Preston Peer-to-Peer Learning Event

Following the launch event in the Fylde Coast last week, we can now confirm that the first Central Lancashire session, for practices in Chorley & South Ribble and Preston will be held on **Tuesday 26th November**, **9-11am**, **at Preston North End**, **Deepdale Stadium**. Details for a session in the West Lancashire locality will follow soon.

To support all practices to get involved, we have secured funding from the ICB to cover the attendance of one Practice Manager and one Lead GP from each practice, equivalent to 16 SMRs per practice. Equating to a total of £457.60 funding for attending the session. This means your year-end practice SMR target will be reduced by 16.

It's crucial that both a Practice Manager and a Lead GP attend to unlock the full funding from the ICB.

Lung Cancer Referral Audit: Practice Participation and Funding
Opportunity - Lancashire and South Cumbria only

Lancashire & South Cumbria Cancer Alliance are supporting GP Practices in fulfilling the requirements of the PCN DES requirements through two important

projects. The first of these a Learning Event Analysis on pancreatic cancer diagnoses is open and practices are very well engaged. There is still the opportunity to participate in this project – please contact Angela Dunne.

The second project – an audit of Lung cancer cases is now live and practices are invited to review the protocol, sign up to the project and start to complete the process.

The protocol provides guidance and references the EMIS searches, collection tools and submission processes that have been developed to aid practices, alongside dedicated support from the Cancer Alliance.

Both of these initiatives are funded based on activity undertaken and will help practices review their referral processes and outcomes, allowing them to identify key themes and valuable learning points.


If any practice would like an agreement drafting before Abi finishes then please get in touch by **15th November** *for your request to be considered.*
