GPC England Non-Statutory Ballot

As you may be aware the non-statutory ballot to protect our practices has now closed. Thank you to everyone who voted to show they are ready to stand up for a better service for your patients.

The ballot result is being made ready by Civica, who handled the ballot on GPCEs behalf, and will be announced soon with more information regarding next steps.

BMA Response to DDRB Recommendations

The BMA have now responded to the recommendations from the Review Body on Doctors' and Dentists' Remuneration (DDRB), and the Government announcement that these will be accepted in full.

Dr Katie Bramall-Stainer, BMA GP Committee in England Chair, said: "Today's uplift is a step in the right direction, but practice funding today even with this uplift, is not even close to

that it was five years ago. Our concern is that this will come as a blow to many GP Partners who have been trying to make every last penny stretch."

LMC Response to Unhelpful Local Media Coverage

We were made aware in the last week that the Lancashire Telegraph and subsequently the Westmorland Gazette (for Cumbria) have both posted articles on the "best and worst GP practices" based on recently published patient satisfaction data.

As we know this data is extrapolated from a very small sample size and is not wholly reflective of the patient experience. Additionally, both articles make no attempt to provide context to the plight of General Practice and the wider NHS and have the potential to put practices in a difficult position with their patients.

As we have done previously, we have written to both publications to express our dissatisfaction with this type of reporting and the way in which these articles are presented, particularly on social media - inciting people to criticise General Practice.

We have offered to talk to local reporters to highlight some of the issues faced by the profession in the hope that they will add context to their very insensitive reporting. If you come across more articles of this nature, please get in touch.
