RED RAG rating: Specialist medicine not recommended for prescribing in primary care

Progesterone (Prometrium): Recurrent miscarriage

Insulin diluting media: diabetes

Osimertinib: adjuvant treatment of EGFR mutation-+ve non-small-cell lung cancer after complete tumour resection

Tenofovir alafenamide: HIV infection **Molnupiravir:** For treating COVID-19

AMBER 1 RAG rating: (with shared care): Suitable for prescribing in primary care or following specialist

<u>Denosumab 120mg (XGEVA)</u>: continue supply and administering of denosumab 120mg in primary care until new commissioning arrangements are in place.

AMBER 0 RAG rating: Suitable for prescribing in primary care following recommendation or initiation by a specialist.

Dapoxetine: premature ejaculation Nefopam: Pain (non-palliative)

Ivermectin: For other indications when recommended by microbiology. (Remains GREEN in accordance with the Lancashire and South Cumbria operational clinical pathway for outbreaks in care homes and closed settings.

Relugolix-estradiol-norethisterone: Treating symptoms of endometriosis

GREEN RAG rated: suitable for initiation and ongoing prescribing in primary and secondary care

Drospirenone: Contraception (oral progestogen-only)

GREEN restricted RAG rated: Appropriate for initiation and ongoing prescribing in both primary and secondary care provided additional criteria specific to the medicine or device are met, or the medicine is used as described the relevant LSCMMG pathway.

Cytisine: Nicotine dependance

Bismuth subsalicylate: H Pylori eradication

DO NOT PRESCRIBE: Do not prescribe: NOT recommended for use by the NHS in Lancashire and South Cumbria.

Finasteride: post hair transplant, Alopecia

Minoxidil solution and foam: Treatment of Alopecia
